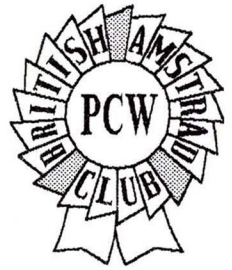

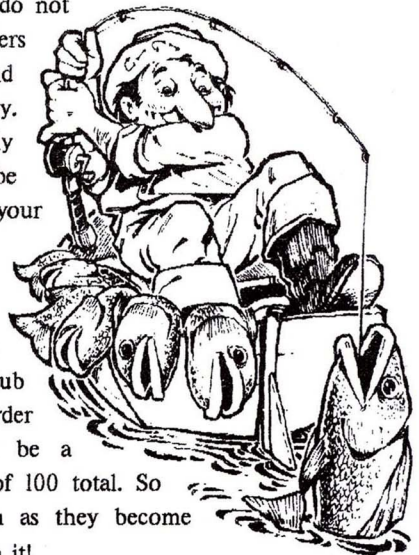

## Chairman's Chatterings

You have just upgraded to LocoScript 4, or MD3 and the Network, on an 8512 or 9512; it might not be a bad idea if you added some more memory (essential for the Network). There's that advert for that second-hand memory pack, 512k or, if you are lucky, 1.5 Mb. That'll make either Loco4 or MD3 purr along. Quite a reasonable price and guaranteed all OK.

Put the cheque in the post and next day it arrives. Make sure that the PCW is disconnected from the mains and that the expansion port at the back is nice and clean. Just a bit of meths on a Q-tip or a gentle rub with an ink rubber, but not hard

enough to damage the metal terminals. *Squeeze* the memory pack onto the back of the port, making sure that it's the right way up, and hold it in place with the two small screws. (They were supplied weren't they?)

Power up and load MD3. It gets as far as the "Loading program" screen and then hangs; nothing more happens. It could be my start of day disc; maybe I need to remake it for this? I'll load up Loco 4 instead – *that* should load alright. Yes, up comes the Disc Manager. Must be OK.

Let's create a new document. Press C for create and, after a moment or so, in the middle of the screen appears this rather unusual message box which I've never seen before:

Error in: Reading SETTINGS  
Not a suitable document

I'm not trying to do anything with a file called Settings. I've not even named my file yet. What does it mean? It means that you've been done and the memory pack is useless. If you want to check it out, reboot the machine with CP/M. When the A> prompt appears remove the CP/M disc, insert your Loco4 disc, type RAMTEST and press [Enter]. It will tell you how much memory it recognises and ask if you want to continue the tests. *Yes!* After a while you will be told that a certain block is faulty. Do you wish to continue? Yes.

Eventually it will tell you how many faults there are. If you are at all doubtful, switch off the machine, *remove* the pack, and then run RamTest on the machine with no add-ons. If that runs OK then you know the fault lies in the additional memory pack – it's duff.

The moral is that you don't buy any second-hand add-on memory packs unless you get a guarantee that it will survive RamTest or you get your money back. RamTest.Com, written by LocoScript Software, comes with Loco4 and is in the PD Library. There is another version of the program with the same name but written by Cirtech instead; both are excellent tests.

In *my* experience be suspicious of memory packs from CSA. Those supplied by Creative Technology (made by Cirtech) are the best. The "end-on" PowerPacks from LocoScript (limited to 512k) seem to vary in quality. (Were some made by CSA?) No matter who the maker, *never* plug in or remove a memory pack whilst your PCW is switched on. It's certain death to the pack and possibly the PCW too!

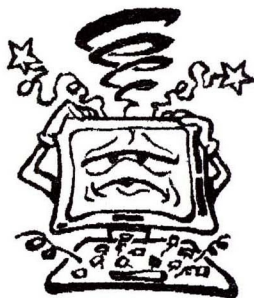
